3 tons = 3000 kilograms 3000 – 770 – 865 = 1365 kilograms Therefore, 1365 kilograms of rice are left over.

9.

1 ton = 1000 kilograms Kangaroo + lion + pig = 50 + 160 + 230 = 440 kg Therefore, kangaroo, lion and pig can cross the bridge at the same time. (Answer may vary)

10.

3 tons = 3000 kilograms Each truck needs deliver: $3000 \div 2 = 1500$ kg Each truck delivers at a time: $1500 \div 3 = 500$ kg Therefore, each truck delivers 500 kg of iron at a time.
