$$348 \div 4 = \$87$$

$$42 \div 5 = 8R2$$

They need to hire 9 boats

9.

Cathy: 96 → 8min; 288 → 24min

Luke: 78 → 6min; 312 → 24min

Luke solved the problems faster

10.

$$1 \text{ ton} = 1000 \text{ kg}$$

$$1000 \div 5 = 200 \text{ bags}$$

11.

$$4L = 4000 \text{ ml}$$

$$4000 \div 8 = 500 \text{ ml/cup}$$

12.

$$6 \text{ km} = 6000 \text{ m}$$

$$6000 \div 400 = 15 \text{ laps}$$

13.

$$585 - 5 = 580 \text{ bottles}$$

$$580 \div 4 = 145$$

Juice at the start: $145 + 5 = 150$ bottles

14.

$$52 \div 2 = 26 \text{ students}$$

15.

Dave: 5 → 45 seconds; $45 \div 5 = 9$ s/question

Fiona: 6 → 60 seconds; $60 \div 6 = 10$ s/question

Dave did faster.
